- **We invite you** to participate in worship with us. In this bulletin, an asterisk * is an invitation to stand if you are able. This worship service will be projected on the screens in the front of the sanctuary. Items in bold indicate the congregation's response.

- **Holy Communion** is open to all who are baptized and trust that Christ is present in the meal, regardless of your tradition or affiliation.
 - To receive communion, proceed to one of the stations as directed by the ushers. Take the bread and receive the cup of wine. Place your empty cup in the bowl as you return to your seat via the side aisle.
 - Gluten-free bread is available at the table in the front center aisle. Remove a wafer from the bowl and pick up a cup of wine or juice, then step forward to hear the words, "given for you."
 - Children who do not yet receive communion or those who are not baptized are encouraged to come forward for a blessing. Cross your arms in front of you to signal your desire for a blessing.
