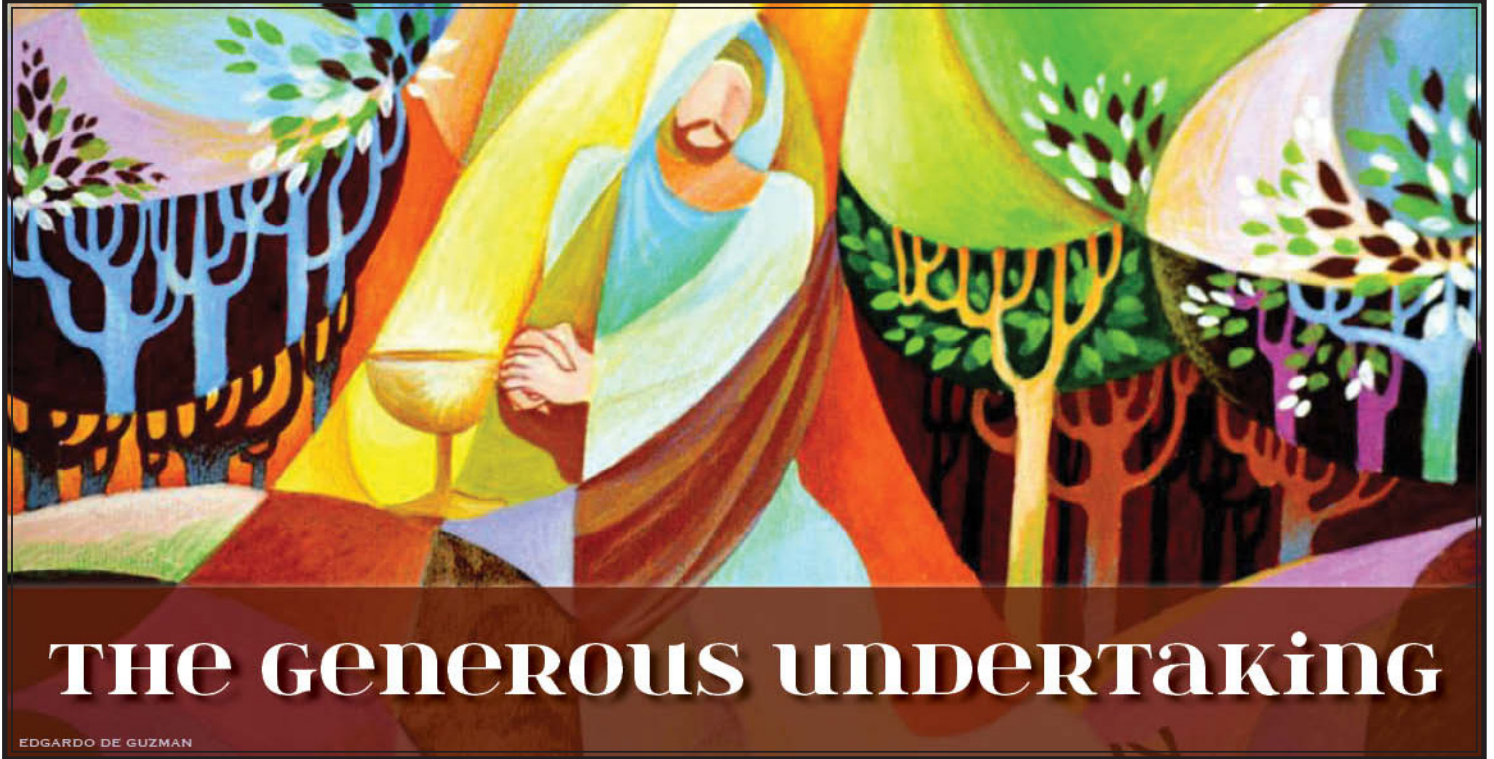

Wednesday Lenten worship videos are posted online at 6:00 am. Subscribe to our YouTube Channel to be notified when new videos are available.

The office is closed until April 6. When the office reopens, the hours will be 9:00 am-3:00 pm, Monday-Thursday. Friday hours will be by appointment only. If you need to meet with a staff member, please make an appointment. If you want to drop off an offering envelope, place it in the black mailbox on the exterior wall by the north doors. All staff members are available to communicate via email; see the staff directory in this bulletin for individual email addresses.

Our food pantry needs canned chicken, canned fruit, canned beans, toilet paper, paper towels, peanut butter, and recently-purchased meat in one-pound packages. We also need clean, used plastic grocery bags. The north doors are open on Mondays from 9:00-11:00 am; meats should be taken directly to the Food Pantry and placed in the freezer. If you are interested in baking, deliver the cookies (may be frozen if baked earlier in the week) to the church on Mondays from 9:00-11:00 am. No need to sign up; they would like to receive several dozen cookies per week.
