

Guidelines for Life Groups

A Life Group is a small group of people who grow together in faith, and in the process care for and support one another.

Each group member is expected to commit to be a part of this group for 6 months, and then every year that commitment is re-evaluated.

The purpose of the group and its mission is established by the group.

Life groups focus on members of the group growing in discipleship through Bible study, with service and fellowship as important elements of each year of ministry.

Materials used for Bible Study need to be consistent with the beliefs and values of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church as a church of the ELCA. The pastors are available to help you if you are unsure.

Groups are open to new members, and ideally groups will choose to have one or two members leave the group and start a new group after at least one year in the original group.

Groups are open to others who are not members of the congregation, though the group facilitator (leader) must be an active member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church.
